

ANGEL'S CROCHET

MISER BAG PATTERN



Materials:

1 ball size 3 thread

1 - 1 1/8" bone ring

size "E" crochet hook

*Larger thread or yarn can be used for this. You will need to change your hook size accordingly and a larger sized bone ring may be needed.

Gauge:

Gauge is not important for this project.

Bag

(note: ch 2 in rounds 1 - 4 do not count as dc, do not slip stitch into them)

Ch 3

Rnd 1: 10dc in 3rd ch from hook, join with sl st to first dc. (10dc)

Rnd 2: ch 2, 2dc in same as joining, 2dc in each dc around, join with sl st to first dc. (20dc)

Rnd 3: ch 2, dc in same as joining, 2dc in next dc, * 1 dc in next st, 2 dc in next stitch* around, join with sl st to first dc. (30dc)

Rnd 4: ch 2, dc in same as joining, dc in next 2 dc, 2dc in next dc, *dc in next 2 dc, 2dc in next dc* around, join with sl st to first dc. (40dc)

Rnd 5 - 12: ch 3, dc in last st of previous round - this will make an "X" - *sk 1 dc, dc in next dc, dc in skipped dc* around, join with sl st in top of beginning ch 3. (20 "X" stitches)

Flap

Row 13: ch 3, sk 2 dc, dc in 2nd skipped dc, dc in 1st skipped dc, *sk 1 dc, dc in next dc, dc in skipped dc* 9 times, dc in next dc, turn. (10 "X" stitches)

Row 14 - 16: ch 3, sk 2 dc, dc in 2nd skipped dc, dc in 1st skipped dc, *sk 1 dc, dc in next dc, dc in skipped dc* 9 times, dc in top of ch 3 of previous row, turn. (10 "X" stitches)

Finish off, weave in ends.

Handle

(note: make sure you do not twist your chains or your ring around)

5 sc in bone ring.

ch 20 - fold flap over or shut - sc through Row 13 into top of Round 12 on opposite side, ch 20, sc in bone ring, repeat 9 times.

sc in ring until it is covered.

Finish off, weave in ends.
