

ANGEL'S CROCHET

SOUP BOWL POTHOLDER PATTERN



This potholder goes up the sides of your soup bowl to help keep your hands from getting scalded when you eat soup.

Potholder

Note: Beginning ch does NOT count as first stitch.

Ch 3

Rnd 1: 10 dc in 3rd ch from hook, join with sl st to first dc. (10dc)

Rnd 2: ch 2, 2 dc in same st as join, 2 dc in each dc around, join with sl st to first dc. (20dc)

Rnd 3: ch 2, 1 dc in same st as join, 2 dc in next st, (1 dc in next st, 2 dc in next st) around, join with sl st to first dc. (30dc)

Rnd 4: ch 2, 1 dc in same st as join, 1 dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, (1 dc in next 2 st, 2 dc in next st) around, join with sl st to first dc. (40dc)

Rnd 5: ch 2, 1 dc in same st as join, 1 dc in each st around, join with sl st to first dc. (40dc)

Rnd 6: ch 2, 1 dc in same st as join, 1 dc in next 2 st, 2 dc in next st, (1 dc in next 3

Materials:

Small amount of WW yarn

size "J" crochet hook

NOTE pattern is worked holding 2 strands of yarn together throughout

Will fit average size soup bowl

Gauge:

Rnd 1 & 2 = 2 1/2" across

Finished size 8" across

st, 2 dc in next st) around, join with sl st to first dc. (50dc)

Rnd 7: ch 1, 1 sc in same st as join, 1 sc in each st around, join with sl st to first dc.
(50sc)

Finish off, weave in ends.

NOTE Yarns may be flammable. Do not place on direct heat or in/over open flame. Not recommended for use in conventional, toaster or microwave ovens.
